


That’s why your first priority when shopping for a motorhome should always be the chassis.





1 ZF™ Independent Front Suspension (optional)—the industry leader


- 60-degree wheel cut offers superior ride, maneuverability and turning radius
- Double-wishbone design offers smooth ride and refined handling
- Excellent center feel and steering response
- Front air-disc brakes with ABS help maintain control and significantly decrease stopping distance

Wide-Track I-Beam Front Axle (not pictured)

- 55-degree wheel cut for tight turning radius and increased maneuverability
- Unique bell-crank virtually eliminates bump steer, which occurs when the steering wheel suddenly moves in reaction to the movement of the suspension
- Air disc brakes standard

2 Standard lowered-engine position allows for a flat-floor rear bedroom and a lower center of gravity for better ride and handling

For engines with a rear radiator, the fan clutch will be standard. The fan clutch helps reduce engine noise and significantly improves fuel economy

4 Heated automatic moisture ejectors eliminate need to crawl under the chassis to drain the air tanks

Infinitely adjustable tilt-and-telescoping steering column provides the ultimate in comfort and safety for drivers of all shapes and sizes.



- ① The Holland Neway® drive-tag rear suspension works as an integrated system to provide optimum ride and handling
- ② Auto-load sensor—an industry first—is an “automatic load proportioning” system that distributes weight proportionately across all three axles ensuring a smoother, more comfortable ride

- ③ CAD-designed coupling plate provides superior strength in high-stress areas
- ④ Five-year, 100,000-mile coolant is pre-charged with SCA
- ⑤ The XC Tag Axle allows for a longer chassis, permitting floor plans with more space and design options



- ⑥ Air-disc brakes with ABS that dramatically decrease stopping distances in virtually all braking conditions, while minimizing fade during rapid or extensive application of the brakes

- ⑦ ZF™ Independent Front Suspension features a 60-degree wheel cut that increases maneuverability, tightens turning radius and offers excellent stability and improved steering

FOUR RAIL CONFIGURATIONS

To meet the needs of all of our customers, the XC Chassis is available in straight-, lowered-, raised-rail and XCM Modular configuration. All rails are constructed of 50,000 psi steel. Here are the features of each:

Straight C-Channel Rail (Standard)

- Rail size: 9.125" x 3" x 0.3125"
- Lowered rear section allows flat floor throughout the coach

Lowered C-Channel Rail (Optional)

- Upper and lower rail size: 9" x 2.75" x 0.25"
- Lowered rear section allows flat floor throughout the coach
- Allows above-the-rail storage
- Rear and side cooling packages
- I-beam front axle, standard; independent front suspension, optional
- Provides coach builder flexibility in basement pass-through storage design
- Lower center of gravity improves handling

Raised C-Channel Rail (Optional)

- Upper and lower rail size: 9" x 2.75" x 0.25"
- Lowered rear section allows flat floor throughout the coach
- Provides flat basement-floor pass-through storage
- Rear and side cooling packages
- I-beam front axle, standard; independent front suspension, optional

XCM Modular

- Allows coach manufacturer more versatility with basement configuration to maximize storage capacity
